	<i>Item</i>	<i>Action Points / Notes</i>
1.	<i>Anti-Bullying Guide</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> School Council are awaiting the completed illustrations from Year 6 pupils before sharing the guide across the school.
2.	<i>Nature garden</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr Tottie explained how the nature garden next to the bike sheds has been rejuvenated by Eco Leaders with the help of Suffolk Wildlife Trust.
3.	<i>Fundraising/Enterprise projects</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils agreed that they think the school does lots of great fundraising already. Some pupils thought it would be nice to raise money for Ukraine. Year 6 pupils said that their summer term enterprise project could raise money for this important cause.
4.	<i>Playground equipment</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils felt that many of the playground balls have gone missing/on the roof. Mr Tottie confirmed a new order would be placed in early April for more break and lunchtime equipment.
5.	<i>School maintenance</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils raised issues with toilets not flushing and doors sticking. All issues passed onto Mrs Noe and Mr Asker for their attention.
6.	<i>School dinners</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils asked whether a wider range of food would be available in the salad bar. Mr Tottie to discuss with the school kitchen staff.
7.	<i>Shaded areas</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils suggested a summer term marquee would be a good way of ensuring there is enough shaded areas on the school site. Mr Tottie pointed out that a marquee on the field would limit the space available for outdoor PE and Sport, however we could investigate playground shading in the sensory garden.
8.	<i>Wet lunch break games</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year 2 pupils requested more board games for their classrooms. Mr Tottie will discuss with the Year 2 team and see if any parents could donate.
