	Item	Action Points / Notes
1.	Planters	Planters have been installed and will be filled with compost and topsoil over half term.
2.	Bird boxes	Bird boxes to be repositioned (one had fallen in high wind).
3.	Eco Schools Application	Eco Schools application to be submitted before the end of the autumn term.
4.	Litter	A new litter picking schedule has been developed for Tuesday/ Thursday lunchtimes. New bins are being purchased to stop seagulls removing litter from the bins.
5.	Energy consumption	Eco Leaders looked at how much water and electricity/gas we are using in school. It would be great to set a target to lower this annually. (Consumption much lower in 2020 due to lockdown)
6.	Whole school presentation	 Eco Leaders are planning to make PowerPoint presentations to be shared in assemblies.
7.	Sensory garden	 Eco Leaders to tidy sensory garden on rota basis. New equipment can be purchased once area is cleared. Eco Leaders have been provided with gloves and bags to collect litter and garden waste in. Many Eco Leaders would like to plant bee friendly flowers.
8.	Environmentally friendly travel	 The Eco Leaders were delighted to hear that the new electric car charger has been installed in the car park after their request last year.
9.	Surfers against Sewerage/Grant application	 Eco Leaders have signed up to Plastic Free Schools Mr Tottie has applied for an environment grant- if successful we will have a new 'Critter Cabin'.
10.	Hot Bins	Several Eco Leaders suggested that the school invest in a 'hot bin' to encourage compost.
11.	Recycling Bins	Year 6 Eco Leaders are going to make new recycling bins labels for the school.
