

Year 3 Home Learning Menu - ~ Spring 2026

(2nd half)

For this half term, please aim to complete a piece of homework each week from this menu. Home learning should be handed in every Monday. Remember to read regularly, practise spellings and complete Mathematics tasks.

Make a rainforest animal (draw, paint, collage, sew, knit, junk model, bake, origami).	Make a 3D model of the rainforest layers, for example, in a shoebox.	Design a new character for your favourite story. Write a character description including adjectives, adverbs and inverted commas.
Use a paper plate to draw a pizza or cookie and practise sharing the whole into different parts. What fractions do you have?	Research a South American rainforest animal. Present your findings in a way of your choice (eg Powerpoint, poster, fact file, leaflet).	Draw a graph comparing the monthly temperatures of a city/town in Brazil and a city/town in the UK.
Create a collage of a well-balanced diet. Think about the different food groups.	Measure the perimeter of 5 things around your house.
