

# Year 3 Home Learning Menu - Summer 2

For this half term, you are expected to complete a piece of homework each week from the menu PLUS the maths sheet which will be sent home weekly. Home learning should be handed in every Friday.

Addition Pyramids (sheet supplied)	What would Bear Grylls do? Imagine that Bear Grylls is making a film about Stone Age survival. Make him a survival guide (a booklet or poster) full of top tips on how to survive in the Stone Age period.	Complete the scales sheets. If you want to add a practical activity, make something to eat that requires you to weigh the ingredients. Notice on the scales how many grams are in a kilogram. Write out the recipe you used and then write the quantity you would need of each ingredient if you doubled the recipe.
Read a book and write a review. Include your favourite part and a brief description of the main characters.	Adverbs of time and place (sheet supplied).	Research Mary Anning. Find out who she was and what she did. Present your findings as a fact file or poster.
Apostrophes for possession (sheet supplied).	Present perfect tense (sheet supplied).	Practise telling the time.
