Maths



English

- Viking long ship reading comprehension *
- Use your recently learnt journalist skills to write a report on the Viking's raid! Create your own, or use the template sheet. *
- Choose one or more of the Viking Gods to research and write about.
- We can tell where the Vikings settled in Britain by names of towns and villages today. Some of the names of places in Britain are made up of Viking words, for example, names ending in 'by' meant farm or village. Look at a map of Britain and write a list of places you can find with this Viking ending. Make sure it's neatly presented.
- Correct the spelling and punctuation mistakes activity sheet 'Knot Such a Grate E-Male. *
- Practise changing sections of writing from the present tense to the past tense, using the sheet 'Tense Tales'. *





Topic

 Using the Vikings Runes sheet, write some messages to us about what you think of the Vikings. You might like to write the answers for us under a flap! *



- Make a Viking helmet, shield, longship or piece of jewellery (tin foil and lollypop sticks could be a handy resource!)
- Use Google to search for different Viking brooch designs, sketch one that you find or, using the knowledge gained, sketch your own design.
- Using collage techniques that you have learnt, make a collage of anything of your choice. It could be a bearded Viking face, a lightbulb or an animal, literally anything you choose.
- Complete a 'Switch Survey' of the types of electrical switches you can find in your home. *

Complete one piece of homework each week. Bring your homework to school on a Thursday.
