


Year 3 Home Learning Menu - Spring 1

This is our home learning menu for the first half of the Spring Term. Please select a task and hand it in on Monday of each week. Homework will be shared with the class and displayed in the classroom. In addition to the home learning menu, children will be given spellings every Monday (to be tested the following Monday). It would also be very helpful if you could continue to read with your child as often as possible.

Produce a picture of a river in a medium of your choice (paint/draw/collage). Perhaps you might like to copy the style of a famous artist.	Explain the process of fossilisation.	Select a variety of animals and sort them into whether they have an endoskeleton, exoskeleton or hydrostatic skeleton.
Complete two activities set on Mathletics.	Draw some arrays (such as below) or make your own with objects at home. What are the different possible multiplication and division number sentences?  $5 \times 4 = 20$ $4 \times 5 = 20$ $20 \div 4 = 5$ $20 \div 5 = 4$	Measure different objects you might find at home or outside. Measure these in millimetres, centimetres and metres. Which is the most appropriate measurement and why?
Pick your favourite book. Design a new front cover and write a new blurb.	Write a recount of something interesting you have done recently. Remember to keep a consistent tense. Use adverbs to tell the reader how, when, where and how often you did something.	Draw a table and make a list / draw pictures of animals which have an exoskeleton, endoskeleton and hydrostatic skeleton.
