For this half term, please complete a piece of homework each week from the menu. Home learning is also set weekly on Mathematics. Please bring these to school each Monday.

Look at the weather each day. Create a bar chart to show the temperature throughout the week.	What would Bear Grylls do? Imagine that Bear Grylls is making a film about Stone Age survival. Make him a survival guide (a booklet or poster) full of top tips on how to survive in the Stone Age period.	Look around your house. What angles can you spot? Are they acute or obtuse angles?
Read a book and write a review. Include your favourite part and a brief description of the main characters.	Build / draw a Stone Age home. You could use cardboard, recycled materials and sticks!	Plant some seeds. Measure and record their growth. Present your findings in a format of your choice.
Create your own word search with words ending in 'chure' spelt 'ture'.	Daily mile challenge – walk, run, jog or exercise for 10 – 15 minutes each day. Make a pictogram to show your activities for a whole week.	Practise telling the time.
