Wraparound childcare questionnaire

If you are a parent of a child aged 0-11, Suffolk County Council need your help to tell them how and where they should plan extra provision to be most convenient to parents.

'Wraparound' provision will be increased where there is demand – this means term time childcare before school (from 08:00am) and after school (until 18:00pm). Wraparound provision can be with a school, or with a private, voluntary or independent provider or with a registered childminder.

Wraparound care is a service which would need to be paid for by families.
