Friday 19th September 2025

This week pupils across the school have been thinking about their feelings, mental health and how to stay safe. On Tuesday we were visited by staff from charity Kids Inspire, who delivered assemblies around managing emotions and promoting positive mental health. They also ran workshops for our Year 6 pupils to promote resilience, which we know is the biggest factor in preventing mental health problems. Children learned about skills and attributes which build resilience, and were then tasked with building lego robots under some challenging and frequently-changing rules.



Classes have also had NSPCC assemblies this week called “Speak Out, Stay Safe”. This is ahead of workshops next week where children will discuss which behaviours are OK and which are not. In the coming weeks we will be asking every pupil to identify an adult in their yeargroup who they would go to if they have a problem.

We want all of our children to feel safe and well; in addition to our safeguarding responsibilities we know that children can only thrive when feeling safe.
